A tick indicates the places and sights we managed to visit. Keisei Ueno Station, at which the Keisei Skyliner arrives from Narita Airport, is a 4 min walk from our hotel, Centurion Hotel Ueno.

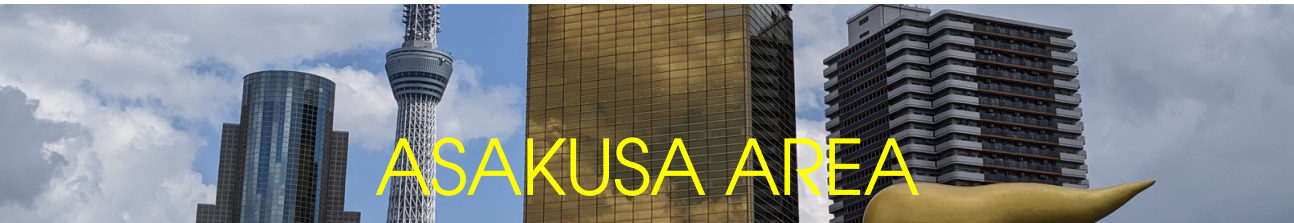

✓ Asahi Beer Hall	3 min walk - From Asakusa Station or 6 min walk from Sensoji Temple  Walk via Sumida Bridge	Beer and Pizza with great views over Tokyo from the Asahi Sky Room on the 22nd Floor
✓ Sumida Park	2 min walk - From Asakusa Station	Cherry Blossoms line the Sumida River
Kappabashi Dougu Street (Kitchenware Town)	12 min walk - From Asakusa Station	Famous for Kitchen utensils, Plastic Food

✓ Hamarikyu Gardens	<i>9 min walk - From Tsukiji Outer Fish Market</i>  <i>OR</i>	Tea at Nakajima no ochaya

Samurai Cruise on Tokyo Bay	<i>30 min walk - From Hamarikyu Gardens</i>	
✓ Rainbow Bridge	<i>30 min walk - Across Bridge - From Tokyo Bay mainland to Odaiba</i>	Connects Tokyo Bay mainland to Odaiba. A Pedestrian Promenade links observation rooms at each end, with views to Mt Fuji
Odaiba	<i>Take Yurikamome Monorail starting from Shimbashi Station to Toyosu - Tuna Market (circular track)</i>  <i>OR</i>  <i>By ferry from Hinode Pier to Odaiba Seaside Park or Palette Town, via Tokyo Big Sight</i>	Odaiba Beach - Statue of Liberty and views of Rainbow Bridge, Fuji TV Building with huge metal ball.  Grand Pacific Le Daiba Hotel - for drink in Skylounge with views
